Golden Plains Community Hospital (GPCH) <https://goldenplains.org/> in Borger, Texas is seeking a Case Manager/Swing Bed Coordinator (CM/SBC) to serve their facility. The CM/SBC is responsible for facilitating the delivery of cost-efficient, individualized and coordinated care to patients. Assist with coordination of patients, patient’s families, physicians and interdisciplinary team in order to promote optimal social functioning and utilization of resources. Educates, develops, organizes and implements programs, policies and procedures to facilitate continuity of care. Develops and implements patient teaching.

The successful candidate should possess a minimum of three (3) years’ experience in a healthcare setting with a working knowledge of managed care principles, available community resources and alternative healthcare delivery systems, working directly with patients, families, staff and third-party payers. This person needs to be able to function independently and have flexibility, personal integrity and the ability to work effectively with patients, staff, Medical staff and support agencies. Must demonstrate strong interpersonal and communication skills with an understanding of medical terminology plus understand basic principles of adult education.

Candidate must be a graduate of a school of nursing with a current license as a Registered nurse in the State of Texas.

GPCH is a state-of-the-art 25 bed, For-Profit, CAH. There are 15 medical/surgical beds, 7 obstetrical beds, and 3 ICU beds, 2 surgery suites, an endoscopy suite, a day surgery center, full service lab and radiology (including a 64 slice CT Scanner, nuclear camera, ultrasound, digital mammography, digital fluoroscopy, MRI, and bone density services). The facility also includes rehab (PT/OT/ST), wound management, swing bed, an onsite clinic, and a separate Specialty Clinic that houses Borger OB/GYN, Borger General Surgery and Borger Orthopedics. The ER is level IV ER/trauma facility staffed 24 hours a day, seven days a week. GPCH has 3 satellite clinics: Fritch Medical Clinic (Fritch), Stinnett Medical Clinic (Stinnett), and the Golden Plains Walk-In Clinic (Borger).

The city of Borger is centrally located in the Texas Panhandle and is known as the “Gateway to the Texas Plains” and is the largest city in Hutchinson County, Texas. The city is located 40 miles northeast of Amarillo TX. “Borger maintains 24 parks, boasts 2 golf courses, and is home to some of the friendliest people you will ever meet.”

GPCH offers a competitive salary and benefits package plus relocation (up to \$5,000) and a housing allowance.
