CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER PORT LAVACA, TEXAS

Memorial Medical Center (MMC) is a progressive community hospital currently seeking someone experienced for the position of Chief Financial Officer (CFO) to serve their facility. Located in Port Lavaca, Texas, MMC's hospital and health clinics provide acute care to the residents in Calhoun County and the entire Crossroads area. Several years ago, the hospital began a progressive expansion by adding physicians and specialties to provide specialized healthcare locally so residents would not have to travel long distances when specialized quality services were needed.

The successful candidate for the CFO position will have three to five (3-5) years of acute care hospital finance experience in leadership positions, along with exemplary communication, presentation, and interpersonal skills to provide dedicated customer service in an economically diverse community. They should possess a minimum of a Bachelor's degree in business, accounting or finance; a Master's degree and CPA certification is preferred but not required. Rural and community hospital, as well as CAH experience is also preferred.

Must understand how to motivate and inspire staff to achieve optimal results, while keeping employee satisfaction high. The candidate must be ready to assist the CEO in positioning the hospital for the future.

MMC is a Critical Access Hospital (CAH) providing general medical and surgical services including a 6-bed Intensive Care Unit (ICU). Other services offered include General Surgery; Labor & Delivery; Radiology, which includes MRI, CT, Mammography, Ultrasound and Bone Density; Rehabilitation including Cardiac and Pulmonary Rehab. The Emergency Department is designated as a Level IV Trauma Center which provides care for patients suffering from a variety of injuries and illnesses and is staffed 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Other services offered include; Accredited CLIA Laboratory, Nuclear Medicine, Respiratory Therapy, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy and Sleep Studies; as well as Outpatient clinics providing specialized services.

The city of Port Lavaca is the county seat of Calhoun County in Southern Texas on the west side of Lavaca Bay (an arm of Matagorda Bay) of the Gulf of Mexico and part of the Victoria, Texas Metropolitan Statistical Area. Port Lavaca is 30 miles southeast of Victoria and 120 miles southwest of Houston.
