CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER BRECKENRIDGE, TEXAS

Stephens Memorial Hospital (SMH) in Breckenridge, Texas is seeking an experienced Chief Executive Officer (CEO) to serve their facility. The candidate should exhibit high moral integrity, superior communication skills, and strong financial management. Primary responsibilities of the CEO will be to provide direction and administration of all aspects of hospital district activities to assure quality patient care and regulatory compliance.

SMH is a comprehensive healthcare system that serves Stephens County and surrounding counties. It is comprised of Stephens Memorial Hospital and Breckenridge Medical Center. A 40-bed licensed hospital, SMH provides general medical and surgical care for inpatient, outpatient and has a 24-hour per day, seven-day per week emergency room that is designated as a Level IV trauma center. The hospital provides acute care admission, outpatient surgery, cardiology, outpatient physical therapy, cardiac rehab, laboratory, routine radiology, CT, MRI, & Ultrasound, skilled nursing care as well as respiratory care and modern state-of-the-art equipment to help diagnose and treat medical needs. SMH also provides prison and county jail health.

The successful candidate should possess a minimum of a bachelor's degree (master's degree in hospital administration preferred) and a minimum of ten (10) years as a senior level hospital executive with five (5) of those years as CEO in an independent acute care hospital. A comprehensive working knowledge of rural hospitals, QIPP, hospital district and Critical Access Hospital (CAH) is required (SMH is currently pursuing CAH status).

Breckenridge is the county seat of Stephens County (population 9,343) and is a progressive community with a great quality of life as well as extensive educational and business opportunities. Breckenridge is surrounded by three area lakes. Situated at the intersection of U.S. Highways 180 and 183, it is approximately 100 miles west of Dallas/Fort Worth, 59 miles south of Wichita Falls, 150 miles northwest of Waco and 58 miles northeast of Abilene. Breckenridge has an airport with a 5000-foot runway and an Automated Weather Observation System. Breckenridge has a great school system and a local Texas State Technical College. There are three higher education colleges within 55 miles and two Junior Colleges within 30 miles of Breckenridge TX.
